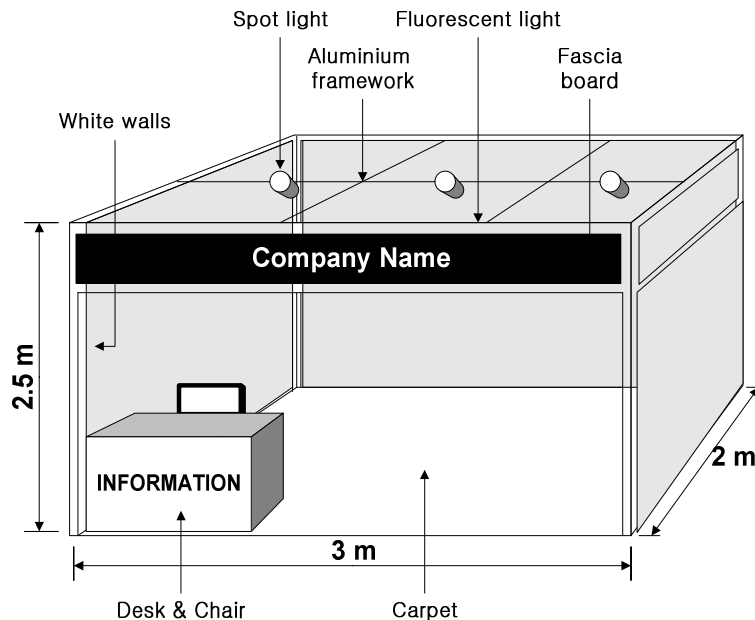

TERMS OF REFERENCE

In these terms and conditions for exhibiting, the term "Exhibitor" shall include all employees, partnership, firm or individual to whom space has been allocated for the purpose of exhibition. The term "Organizer" shall mean "6ICI Secretariat". The term "Exhibition" shall mean "6TH International Conference on Isotopes".

BOOTH ALLOCATION

The Organizer shall allocate the space in accordance with the nature of the exhibit or in the manner the Organizer deems fit. The Organizer shall reserve the right to change the space allocated to the Exhibitor at any time prior to the commencement of the build-up of the exhibition should the circumstances require changes. Such changes shall be at the discretion of the Organizer. The Exhibitor shall not claim for compensation as a result of the changes.

APPLICATION AND PAYMENT PROCEDURES

Applications should be sent to Organizer along with a remittance slip (copy of a bank) paying for the 100% of the participation fee and/or shell cost. Additional Utility Application fee should be paid by March 31, 2008.

CANCELLATION

Cancellation will only be accepted under unavoidable circumstances. In the case of changing exhibits or canceling the exhibition, exhibitors should inform the organizer in writing. Charge for cancellation received prior to April 15, 2008 is 50% of total participation fee. And refunds for cancellation received after April 16, 2008 will not be accepted.

INSTALLATION AND REMOVAL

The installation and removal of the exhibits and booths must be completed by the date and time stipulated by the Organizer. Exhibitors shall indemnify the Organizer against any loss which may be caused by delay or damage to the Exhibition Hall.

COORDINATION OF EXHIBIT WITH ORGANIZER

Exhibitors shall provide descriptions of their exhibits before the construction of the exhibits and ensure compliance with regulations and restrictions on booth design and activity. Exhibitors shall also agree to provide the Organizer with the necessary information facilitating the overall promotion of the Organizer.

INSURANCE, SECURITY AND SAFETY

USE OF EXHIBIT SPACE

Exhibitors are bound to exhibit the announced products and to man the stands with competent personnel during the open hours of the Exhibition. Activities of the Exhibitor shall be confined within limits of the Exhibitor's booth. The exhibit will be consistent with the theme of the exhibition and the Organizer reserves the right to restrict.

RESTRICTION ON SELLING

It is agreed that the sole purpose for contracting exhibit space to display and/or demonstrate equipment, supplies and/or services. Cash sales within the confines of the exhibit space are prohibited.

LIABILITY

It is mutually agreed that the Organizer shall not be liable to the Exhibitors for any damage to and/or loss of the Exhibitor's property, or for injuries to persons resulting from any cause. All claims for any such loss, damage, or injury, are expressly waived by the Exhibitors.

BREACH OF CONTRACT AND WITHDRAWAL BY EXHIBITOR

In the event that the Exhibitor refuses to use all or part of the space allocated or the Exhibitor defaults on the payment, the Organizer shall have the right to terminate the contract forth with. In addition, the stand charges shall not be refunded. If the Exhibitor withdraws from participation without the Organizer's approval, the already paid money by the Exhibitor shall not be refund.

CHANGES
