

**Memorandum of Understanding**

*BETWEEN*

**The World Council on Isotopes**

*AND*

**The RCA (Regional Cooperative Agreement for Research, Development and Training Related to Nuclear Science and Technology for Asia and the Pacific) Regional Office**

The World Council on Isotopes is an international organization established in 2008 for a purpose of building a global network and providing a forum to address important issues relating to the safe production and use of stable and radioactive isotopes for global well-being.


The RCA Regional Office is an international organization established in 2002 to increase visibility and viability of the RCA, an intergovernmental agreement among IAEA Member States of Asia and the Pacific for research, development and training related to nuclear science and technology.

The World Council on Isotopes and the RCA Regional Office hereby agree to collaborate to promote mutual benefits between the two parties through the encouragement of the following activities;

- 1) Exchange of information, documents and publications
- 2) Exchange of resources
- 3) Development of joint programmes

This Memorandum shall become effective from the date of last signature and shall remain effective for five years. This Memorandum will be automatically renewed at the end of the five years unless one or both of the parties propose otherwise.

Both parties shall send a written notice and consult the other party at least six months before revision or termination of the Memorandum.
